# CLOSING DATE FOR REGISTRATION is 28st April 2017

Registration for each round is a very important part of the planning. Submitting registration forms as well as proof of payment is compulsory for every round. You will not receive any samples if you do not comply with these two requirements.

Please complete the registration form attached in full and e-mail it back to the PT provider. Invoices will and can only be issued after the duly completed registration forms were received.

# EXERCISE NOTIFICATION

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# SCOPE:

The round involved the distribution of six samples which will be prepared as follows:

**Sample 1, 2 and 3:** Sulphate, Chloride, Fluoride, Nitrate, Phosphate and Conductivity at 25°C in mS/m, Total Dissolved solids at 180°C in mg / I [Gravimetric method only]

**Sample 4,5 and 6 :**Calsium,Magnesium,Sodium,Potassium,Iron,Manganese,Aluminium,Lead Zinc, Chromium, Nickel, Arsenic, Cadmium and Cobalt
